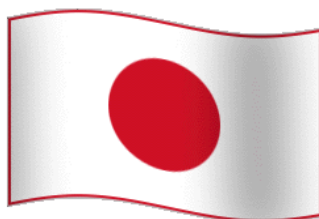

<b>Project</b> (Longer-task assignments that are designed to demonstrate learned concepts.)	20%
