DESCRIPTION OF COURSE

3. To participate in all facets of fundraising.
4. To unify our school into a solid group, working together to better the community.

1. Students are required to help run and organize barbecues, movie snacks, and other events.
2. Students will serve as clerks for the student store and occasionally organize the

lunch services.

3. Students will advertise events such as movies and holiday competitions.
4. Students **MUST** remain until at least 4:15, after events to help clean up.
5. Students should be on time for class every day.
6. Students are expected to be promoters of the student council led events and good representatives of TIPS. Our goal is to unify the school and maintain positive attitudes.
7. Students will support fellow student council members in every way.
